- If the scholarship is awarded, the student is responsible for submitting the name, mailing address and phone number of the institution that the funds should be sent to within 14 business days of award date.
- If the student does not attend the school that was indicated in this application, it is the student's responsibility to let the Town of Firestone know. College award letters must be provided as soon as they are available.
- Students may only apply for one out of the three scholarship opportunities.

The Town of Firestone will present the *Excellence in Academics Scholarship* to two qualifying seniors. The students will be awarded \$1,000 each toward their education.

The following criteria must be met in order to apply:

- Currently a high school senior
- A current resident of the Town of Firestone
- Minimum overall 3.5 grade point average
(If home schooled, more weight will be placed on ACT or SAT scores)
- Submit a 500 word essay answering the following question:
“What inspired me to continue my education and why do I think it is important to attend college?”
- Present evidence of community involvement
(Excluding school-related service)
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a school counselor, principal or a community leader

One or more of the following should be submitted with the application:

- School transcript of grades
- ACT or SAT Scores



Town of Firestone Career Advancement Scholarship Criteria

The Town of Firestone will present the *Career Advancement Scholarship* to one qualifying senior. The student will be awarded \$1,000 toward his/her education.

The following criteria must be met in order to apply:

- Currently a high school senior
- A current resident of the Town of Firestone
- Minimum overall 3.0 grade point average
(If home schooled, more weight will be placed on ACT or SAT scores)
- Submit a 300 word essay answering the following question:
“What career do I plan to pursue and why is this important to me?”
- Present evidence of community involvement
(Excluding school-related service)
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a school counselor, principal or a community leader

One or more of the following should be submitted with the application:

- School transcript of grades
- ACT or SAT Scores



SAFEbuilt Academic Excellence Scholarship Criteria

The Town of Firestone will present the *SAFEbuilt Academic Scholarship* to one qualifying senior. The student will be awarded \$1,000 toward his/her education.

The following criteria must be met in order to apply:

- Currently a high school senior
- A current resident of the Town of Firestone
- Minimum overall 3.5 grade point average
(If home schooled, more weight will be placed on ACT or SAT scores)
- Submit a 300 word essay regarding their chosen profession.
- Present evidence of community involvement
(Excluding school-related service)
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a school counselor, principal or a community leader
